





Investment in capacity building, strategic planning and business development needed for communities to take advantage of opportunities




Innovation has been successful

Projects have strong returns


✤ Dozens of projects with ROI's > 20%

Examples of success include:


- ✤ Lignin: FPInnovations → TBay pilot → WestFraser's plant & plywood...
- Cellulose Fibrils: from lab to new products in less than four years...
- Advanced Building Systems: building on CLT, wood panels and engineered beams with tall wood buildings and building codes

Collaboration: working with new stakeholders, including non-traditional actors
